ROAD REPORT 2016

IN JULY, THE STEVE WIGGIN CREW SWEPT THE ROADS WITH THEIR RIDE-ON MECHANICAL SWEEPER AND ED SHEARER CUT BACK THE INFRINGING GROWTH ON THE SIDES OF THE ROADS.

LAST YEAR, ASPHALT REPAIRS WERE MADE ON SHORT SECTIONS OF WOOD WAY AND THE WILLOWS ROAD. THE BIG ITEM WAS CUTTING OUT TREE ROOTS AND FILLING HOLES, FOLLOWED BY 371 FEET OF BLACK TOP PAVING ON PINE ROAD.

FOUR PROJECTS WERE, THEN, PUT ON HOLD, THREE OF WHICH ARE NOW ON THE SCHEDULE FOR LATER THIS MONTH.

- 1. ASPHALT GRINDINGS WILL BE APPLIED ON WOOD WAY TO COVER POT HOLES AND ROUGH AREAS.
- 2. THE INTERSECTION OF WOOD WAY AND LEDGE ROAD (30 feet X 30 feet) WILL BE PREPARED AND PAVED.
- 3. THE WIGGIN CREW WILL EXCAVATE ON THE FOREST SIDE OF CLIFF ROAD. THEY WILL DIG A TRENCH (2 feet wide by 130 feet long), LINE IT WITH FABRIC, AND FILL IT WITH RIP RAP (2 inch to 3 inch stones) FOR PROPER DRAINAGE.
