Road Committee Report

Phil and I walked the roads and checked the culverts. Thanks to Alan Abel, Bob and Carolee Ziegenhagen most of the roads were in good condition except for a few areas that need attention. Our suggestions for 2018-2019 are:

- 1) North Lane (Town road) upper portion at junction with Cliff Road is eroded and pavement has disintegrated. We will meet with the Town Highway Department/Tom Walker this summer to expedite repairs.
- 2) West Lane roots have caused washboard speed bumps. If the Board agrees we could contact Steve Wiggin for proposals on repair and will present his suggestions at the fall meeting.
- 3) Annually, we should continue to flush culverts in the fall after leaf drop, mechanically sweep the roads in the early spring, trim overhanging branches, and mow the edges in early to mid summer.
- 4) Ledge Way may benefit from a mirror at junction with Woodruff Way. We will price options and present them to the board.
